The subject of potholes in the roads around Galley Hill being an ongoing problem for drivers in

the area is one we at GHRA would like to address. The committee have been seeking alternative ways to get the much needed repairs done, when the council are telling us there is a lack of funds and place it low on their priorities.

There is a scheme being used in some parts of the UK where the local councils train a few residents in repairing smaller potholes, and supply the necessary materials, training and equipment. We are proposing to approach the local MK Council with this idea, and to see if some volunteers could be found (including ourselves) to carry out the smaller road repairs on low traffic areas around Galley Hill.

We are currently asking if local residents have any objections to us approaching the Council to see if we could possibly get them to agree to this. If you do object please could you contact us before the next committee meeting on May 18th. If we hear no objections, we can assume that people are happy for us to explore this idea with the council to hopefully improve our area.


